A review of the emails you sent on January 17, 2021 raise some questions that I present because they may affect your current litigation.

1) Gooch's Advance Fee Retainer dated December 16, 2016 is for an "excessive fees case" against Popovich and his law firm and nominees and not for legal malpractice.

Do you have a separate attorney-client agreement for the legal malpractice case ?

2) the Clinton agreement documents speaks to legal malpractice and breach of fiduciary duty. Was there a second suit for breach of fiduciary duty ?

3) the Clinton agreement documents indicate their belief that the Gooch Firm had also served an attorney's lien on your proceeds.

There may be two attorney liens already on your current matter.

Was December 16, 2016 when you discussed the legal malpractice of Popovich and Mast?

If so, did they tell you why it is characterized as excessive fees ?

Did you get my response asking that the balance payments be in multiple checks as you suggested?
